Cuvée MEOW, Cremen d'Alsace AOC

Price: \$195

Grape: 50% Pinot Blanc, 50% Auxerrois Blanc

Tasting Note: Sparkling wine made with traditional Champagne method, by Vignoble Klur, a biodynamic estate in Katzenthal, Alsace. Fresh and rich on the nose. Green apples, flowers, and fresh creams. Fine bead of bubbles. Big impact on the palate, lots of extracts and flavors. Direct but persistent. Refreshing and food friendly.

No sulfite, no headache

Sulfite is a preservative widely used in winemaking to avoid oxidation but excessive levels of sulfite in a wine is often blamed for headaches. *Cuvée Meow* is the perfect illustration of a wine not masked by sulfites – goodbye headache!

Cuvee Meow – The label

“Katz” means Cat in German, and hence the Cat on the label (Alsace is closely associated with Germany in history). Thus far, the “Cat labelled” Cremen d’Alsace is only available in Hong Kong and in Japan, where it is named “*Cuvee Manekineko*” (招財貓) and is featured in issue 35 of the famous Japanese wine comic *Les Gouttes de Dieu* 《神之水滴》.

A Pair of fun and delightful Black & White Cat*

2015 Gentil de Katz (black cat)

Price: \$168

Style: Dry

Grape: blend of Pinot Blanc, Pinot Gris, Gewurztraminer

Tasting Note: Nose of lychee, rose, and pineapple. Round and full on the palate, with hint of acidity and mineral.

2015 Voyou de Katz (white cat)

Price: \$168

Style: Extra-dry

Grape: blend of Riesling, Sylvaner, Muscat

Tasting Note: Nose of white flowers, kiwi, and apple. Delicate and crispy on the palate, with hint of mineral.

**Black and White cat need to be purchased together.*

Two Gewurztraminer

2011 Gewurztraminer, Grand Cru Wineck-Schlossberg

Price: \$290

Tasting Note: Bright golden colour with silvery reflection. Notes of very mature honey melon and grapefruit, making a complex and elegant wines. Expressive flavours on the palate and double the unctuous texture.

2007 Gewurztraminer, Vendange Tardive

Price: \$470

Tasting Note: Grapes from 55-year-old vines, a small harvest (20 hl/ha), this bottle offers an intense and complex bouquet. Aromas of exotic fruits such as mango and papaya blend in with a touch of honey and grapes, perfectly overripe. Vivid and lively when opened and soon evolve into a smooth full-flavoured wine. The residual sugar reminds of late harvest. Always keep a bottle for special moments!



Background Information



About Vignoble Klur

Located in Katzenthal, the centre of Alsatian wine region, the Klur estate has been following the way of biological cultivation, ecology and biodynamic practices since 1999. The characteristic of Katzenthal is the 500 million years old geological crevasse. Grapes for the Cuvée Meow are largely coming from 40 years old Pinot Blanc and Auxerrois Blanc planted by the father of present winemaker Clemant Klur on a plot with sandy and alluvial soil.

What is Cremant d'Alsace?

Cremant d'Alsace is an AOC for sparkling wines made in Alsace wine region, France. Wines are elaborated according to the methods used for the Champagne elaboration. The allowed varieties are Riesling, Pinot Blanc, Pinot Gris, Auxerrois Blanc, and Chardonnay.
